Discussion Questions:

1. What is something new you learned about the scriptures today?
2. How do you feel about the fig tree {hyperbole} illustration? Does it remind you of anything happening in our time? A group or culture that has many advantages and does not use them for the kingdom? How can we be better stewards?
3. Jesus went from very private acts (not telling anyone about him or his miracles) to a triumphant entry that was SUPER PUBLIC. Why now? Why was it time for them to know about him all of a sudden? Read Mark 8:30, now read Mark 11:7-10; discuss.
4. They praised him with Hosanna on Sunday and by Tuesday things start taking a turn downward. Then from the stories of Passion week we know it does not get any better. How does our personal opinion sway to or from Jesus in our own lives or does it? Do we flip sometimes? Why?
5. Jesus asks us to do the hard things for the kingdom as we saw in the Palm Sunday story. Even when He knows there will be challenges and push back from others. Give an example of how that has played out in your personal walk with the Lord.
6. "Jesus drove them out of the Temple and flipped tables." Was this a scripture that bumfuzzled you in the past? What is another example of a righteous indignation/anger? What type anger do you most often display? {Rage, Repressed, Righteous} also See *Ephesians 4:26*
